A NEW HARNESS SYSTEM FOR EXTRA COMFORT AND WEAR RESISTANCE

A key feature of the Dräger PSS™ 7000 is a newly designed harness suspension system that provides the ultimate in comfort and wear. The system features advanced compression-molded comfort padding. Its high temperature performance and exceptional wear resistance make it particularly suitable for firefighters. Additionally, the high grip anti-slide outer surface of the harness is made from a vulcanized chloroprene rubber for the

necessary stability to keep the harness securely in position. Finally, new improvements made to the harness friction buckle design make it quick and easy to don and doff the Dräger PSS™ 7000 SCBA.

A BACKPLATE THAT PROVIDES UNRESTRICTED MOVEMENT

To fit the torso lengths of different fire-fighters, the Dräger PSS™ 7000's carbon fiber composite backplate features a unique 3-position height adjustment. This feature allows the wearer to adjust the height of the backplate within seconds.

The Dräger PSS™ 7000 was also designed to move with the user, allowing for unrestricted movement. The backplate automatically lengthens and pivots to accommodate the user's movements, and the unique self-adjusting, pivoting waistbelt allows the backplate to do this.

In addition to an increased range of movement, the weight of the Dräger PSS™ 7000 rides on the hips to reduce back strain. This also increases stability and balance by providing a lower center of gravity. Ultimately, the design of the Dräger PSS™ 7000 allows the wearer to work more effectively with less fatigue.

Dräger PSS™ 7000 features a Lock and Load system that enables firemen to securely change out their cylinders in about 10 seconds. This unique quarter-turn adapter allows for quick and easy attachment of the cylinder to the adapter, saving time compared to the conventional cylinder hand wheel and cylinder adapter. The Dräger PSS™ 7000 cylinder quick-connect system enables firefighters to reenter a fire situation much more quickly and also allows for mutual cylinder aid or exchange, when presented with a life critical situation.

AN INTEGRATED SAFETY SYSTEM TO MONITOR AIR SUPPLY TIME

With over a decade of electronic personal alert safety system (PASS) experience, Dräger developed the Sentinel™ 7000 — a fully integrated pressure gauge and "Smart Electronic Monitoring Device" that is housed in an impact-resistant water-proof casing. The integrated warning system uses a solid-state surface-mounted accelerometer motion sensor that measures movement on two axes. This provides excellent repeatability and reliability.

Three high temperature resistant sounders — one on the front and two on the rear of the SCBA — in combination with a high-intensity buddy lights system provides an attention-demanding audible warning of >95 dBA in combination with a visual warning to the firefighter as well as other team members on the fire ground.

SMART CARD TECHNOLOGY FOR "REAL TIME" INFORMATION

The Dräger Sentinel™ 7000 can be easily programmed with the firefighter's personal information using Dräger's Smart Card Technology (SCT). This provides "real time" information about the SCBA to the firefighter every 30 seconds. Information such as cylinder pressure and time to low air warning can be downloaded and evaluated at a later time.

POWERED FOR TOTAL RELIABILITY

Both the Dräger PSS™ 7000 SCBA and Sentinel™ 7000 are powered by one central quick-change battery pack system with five AA batteries. An additional CR-123 backup battery enables firefighters to be completely confident in the reliability of the SCBA.
